Proposition 3 will improve various amenities in Case Community Park, Page Park, multiple pedestrian trail segments, the golf course parking lot, the museum, and offer construction of a dog park.

Sports Field Improvements

- Softball sports field lighting (existing lights are rusted at bases, fall hazards)
- Field improvements to playing surfaces for softball, soccer, and baseball



Portable Restrooms

- 3 portable trailer restrooms for Case Park/special events
- BMX-Disc Golf Location
- Soccer location
- Baseball location



Page Park

- Page Park rehabilitation
- New playgrounds including slides, swings, climbing features, and ages 2-12
- Outdoor fitness equipment
- Splash Pad
- Restroom with shelter
- Expanded parking
- Site lighting



Proposition 3

Neighborhood Trail Improvements

- Saddlerock Trail at Highway 97 and 34th Street (Linwood Drive) Adjoins Highway 97 Trail
- Angus Park Trail overlay (stand-alone circular trail)
- Concord Trail rehabilitation (adjoining Boyd Trail)
- SS Lake Trail rehabilitation (adjoins KATY Trail and upcoming 81st W Ave Trail)
- If additional funds are saved, KATY Trail from Highway 97 to Main Street needs rehabilitation



Park Maintenance Expansion

Dog Park

- New park construction at proposed animal welfare facility
- 1 acre +/-, Fenced with Use Zones
- Irrigation and water supply for wet stations
- Pet clean-up equipment
- Hybrid grass for high traffic use
- Site utilities and security lighting
- Site parking with Camera system



Museum

- Interior renovations including detail plaster work on crown molding and damaged wall surfaces
- Additional items as addressed with SSCHMTA



Golf Course Parking Improvements

- Overlay/re-construction of existing parking lot, and overflow lot



The total amount of funding required to execute these projects is \$3,775,000.00. Passage of this proposition would increase ad valorem tax on a \$100,000 home in Sand Springs approximately **\$0.72** per month.
