Proposition 4

The City of Sand Springs has made it a priority to enhance the beautification of the City. We realize, having a vibrant community that matches the great people that live here is important to our citizens. Proposition 4 aims to continue this great work which has cemented positive community growth. This proposition promotes a continued joint working relation-

ship with the Sand Springs Public School District to design and construct a community-gathering place and plaza in the downtown area.



Additionally, funds will provide for community enhancement and aesthetic improvements in

the downtown streetscape. Envisioned is a new look to match the investment of the downtown businesses with increased curb appeal, functional sidewalks and cross-

ings, and beautiful streetscape that matches the triangle.

This proposition will provide for the construction and expansion of paved parking in Case



Community Park. With an evergrowing increase to youth sports play, Case Community Park has never experienced this level of visitation. Formal parking and connectivity for BMX, Softball, and the Great Lawn are at the

forefront of completing the master plan of a community destination park.

The total amount required to fund these projects is \$ 3,710,000.00. Passage of this proposition would increase ad valorem tax on a \$100,000 home in Sand Springs approximately \$0.71 per month.
