Bond that included street overlays and repairs, the soon to be constructed roadway over the levee into Case Community Park, funding for public safety technology, City Park and Trail improvements, City Beautification, funding for Economic Development, and various other projects and needs of the City.

The **2022 G.O. Bond** will bring four questions to you, our citizens, who will decide each of the four questions on **June 28, 2022**. The intent of the proposed Bond Package is to fulfill the wants and needs expressed by our citizens and to meet many of the needs of aging City Buildings, infrastructure, parks, and more. Sand Springs is a great community, but to keep it that way, we must make improvements. G.O. Bonds are used to make the needed investments in communities, and the information in this brochure is meant to educate our citizens on how this plan will let us keep pace with other communities in the metro area. This plan will incorporate 4 propositions that improve Road Overlays and Repair, Public Safety, Parks, and Community Enhancements. This plan will help us keep Sand Springs great. Let's GO Sand Springs!

Proposition #1 - Street and Roadways

Acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, extending, enlarging, improving and repairing streets within said City:

City wide street overlays and repairs	\$4,325,000
Total	\$4,325,000

Proposition #2 – Public Safety Facilities & Equipment

Acquiring, constructing, equipping and improving public safety buildings and facilities and purchasing and installing public safety equipment, hardware and software all to be owned exclusively by said City:

Replacement, upgrade and modernization of citywide storm sirens	\$825,000
Design and construction of Animal Welfare Facility	\$3,090,000
Total	\$3,915,000

Proposition #3 – Parks Improvements and Enhancements

Purchasing, constructing, equipping, improving, extending, renovating, repairing and beautifying public parks and park lands and cultural and recreation facilities, all to be owned exclusively by said City:

Parking lot/expansions for The Canyons at Blackjack Ridge	\$515,000
Sand Springs Cultural and Historical Museum building improvements	\$205,000
Page Park splash pad construction	\$620,000
Construction of Dog Park	\$410,000
Neighborhood trails improvements	\$540,000
Sports Field Improvements	\$1,035,000
Portable Restrooms	\$245,000
Park Maintenance building expansion	\$205,000
Total	\$3,775,000

Proposition #4 – Community Enhancements

Community development purposes within or near the City and acquiring necessary property and lands therefor:

Construction of new parking lots and expansions for Case Community Center	\$1,135,000
Design and construction of community plaza	\$1,030,000.00
Community enhancement and aesthetic improvements and downtown streetscape enhancements	\$1,545,000
Total	\$3,710,000

***Passage of all four propositions in the 2022 GO Bond amounts to \$15,725,000.00, which would cost the average household approximately \$3.00 monthly on a \$100,000 home in Sand Springs.**
